

# Ferlib F VII 12g Boxlock Ejector <br> Serial Number 33455 <br> £3250.00 

## Description

Made by Libero Ferraglio using an Anson \& Deeley scalloped boxlock action with raised side panels. Action is fitted with an automatic safety, two triggers (front blade is spring loaded) and a spindle toplever. Action is brushed bright and hand engraved in a full coverage small arabesque scroll.
$28^{\prime \prime}$ barrels with $23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ chambers, engine turned top rib and choked in the right and and in the left.

Straight hand grip stock is attractively figured and measures $141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to the centre of the chequered butt. The stock has traditional drop points, stock oval and splinter forend with an Anson push rod release.

Overall the gun is in good condition. The stock has some handling marks and the barrel black is worn in places, however it is in sound working condition and sold as is. It is a quality made, very solid boxlock ejector that handles and points very well. A modern and reliable substitute to a vintage gun.
